## **Transportation/Parking**

Atlanta's MARTA transit system runs to and from the Hartsfield-Jackson Airport; exit at the Peachtree Center Station which is connected to the hotel through the Peachtree Center Mall. Fares are \$2.50 each way. If you are driving, there is on-site valet parking and off-site self parking; both may be limited due to high demand.

### **Food**

The Hyatt Regency has a restaurant, the Sway, and a Starbucks in the lobby. The hotel is connected to The HUB in Peachtree Center, which is a food court and has several shops for essentials.
